## **Graduation Requirements**

### **Part A - Description**

Every year a Scattergood student must be enrolled in each of the five core disciplines: **Humanities, Social Studies, Math, Science, and Language.** This requirement is regardless of already completed graduation requirements, unless the academic office approves an alternate plan. As a college preparatory school, we want to ensure that our students have a balanced education. We also realize that college admissions boards recommend that students have a complete program of four years in every academic subject.

<b>Junior Seminar</b>	<b>.5 credit</b>	10 page Junior Research Paper, SAT prep and college search
<b>Senior Seminar</b>	<b>.5 credit</b>	College Prep & Application and 15-20 page Senior Research Paper

### **Part C – Additional Courses**

<b>Art/Project</b>	<b>1 credit</b>	All year, every year a student is enrolled
<b>Physical Education</b>	<b>1 credit</b>	All year, every year a student is enrolled
<b>9th/10th Seminar</b>	<b>.5 credit</b>	All year, 9th and 10th grade
<b>Community Service</b>		30 hours of community service work is required each year

**In order to graduate, every Scattergood student must fulfill a number of course requirements, complete community service projects, finish the requirements of the junior and senior seminar classes, and be admitted to a four-year accredited college or university.**
